INTRODUCTION

- A comprehensive solution requires a balanced approach, integrating diplomatic engagement, economic incentives for North Korea, and robust security measures.
- Addressing the root causes of the conflict, including North Korea's security concerns, is essential for building lasting peace and stability on the peninsula.

Background Information

Korean War Legacy

The Korean Peninsula remains divided since the Korean War (1950-1953), which ended in an armistice but not a peace treaty, leaving North and South Korea technically still at war.

North Korea's Nuclear Development

North Korea began its nuclear program in the 1960s, conducting its first nuclear test in 2006, and has since steadily advanced its missile and nuclear capabilities.

Diplomatic Efforts and Setbacks

Multiple negotiations, including the Six-Party Talks, aimed at denuclearization, have failed to achieve lasting results, with talks frequently disrupted by missile tests or military actions.


Impact on Regional and Global Security


North Korea's Nuclear Program

POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS

Diplomatic Engagement

Restart and sustain multilateral negotiations involving all key stakeholders, including North Korea, South Korea, the U.S., China, Russia, and Japan.

Confidence-Building Measures

Implement measures such as communication hotlines, military de-escalation agreements, and joint humanitarian initiatives to build trust among the involved nations.

Step-by-Step Denuclearization

Develop a phased approach where North Korea agrees to specific disarmament actions in exchange for corresponding economic incentives and sanctions relief.
