INTRODUCTION



- Addressing this challenge requires joint efforts to guarantee that space remains a domain for peaceful exploration and equitable use, while balancing security concerns with international cooperation.


Background Information

SOME CAUSES:

- Geopolitical Rivalries: Tensions between major powers such as the United States, China, and Russia foster a climate in which military presence in space is viewed as an essential for intimidation and power.
- Privatization of Space: The increased engagement of private firms in space research has military implications, as commercial goals frequently align with national security objectives.
- Cybersecurity Concerns: As nations rely more on space-based systems for key infrastructure, they become more vulnerable to cyber assaults, pushing them to strengthen their space defense capabilities.
- Increased Surveillance Needs: The demand for better surveillance and reconnaissance capabilities motivates expenditures in space-based military systems.

Engaging the private sector in discussions about responsible practices is crucial, as is investing in technologies that promote safety without military intent.
